#### (a.k.a. End-of-the-Year Ice Show)

Carnival participation sheets will be out the first week of December and **MUST** be returned before Holiday Break.

**These forms are extremely important** and tell us how many participants we will have in our show so we can start preparing groups, costumes, music, etc., etc.

Yes, you may have filled out the participation on your registration but these forms help us to make sure that you are still interested and the size of costume your child requires.

Volunteers – every parent of a skater in the show will be required to fulfill a duty.

Canskate, Tiny Tot and Junior parents will have dressing room duty. On the form you may indicate your preference of rehearsal, 1pm show, or 7pm show. Every effort will be made to accommodate your request. Parents will be required to stay in the dressing room for their skaters half of the show. Duties include checking the skaters of their group in and out, maintain a quiet room, ensure no skaters leave the dressing room, and walk the skaters to and from their ice presentation.
